

No way is this book worth the money it costs! It is a slim volume that is mostly a reiteration of other books on the subject. It is especially geared to those with a bachelor's degree. This in itself is not a bad thing, but I was hoping for more. It does include salary estimates which is very helpful. Many of the careers suggested have little or nothing to do with psychology. I spent 30 years as a technical writer (one of the careers suggested) and hadn't had any exposure to psychology during that time. All you need for that career is an ability to write good English and translate techno-speak into something John Q Public can understand. Not much psychology there. The same is true of many of the other careers mentioned. See if you can find another book on the subject that is cheaper.
