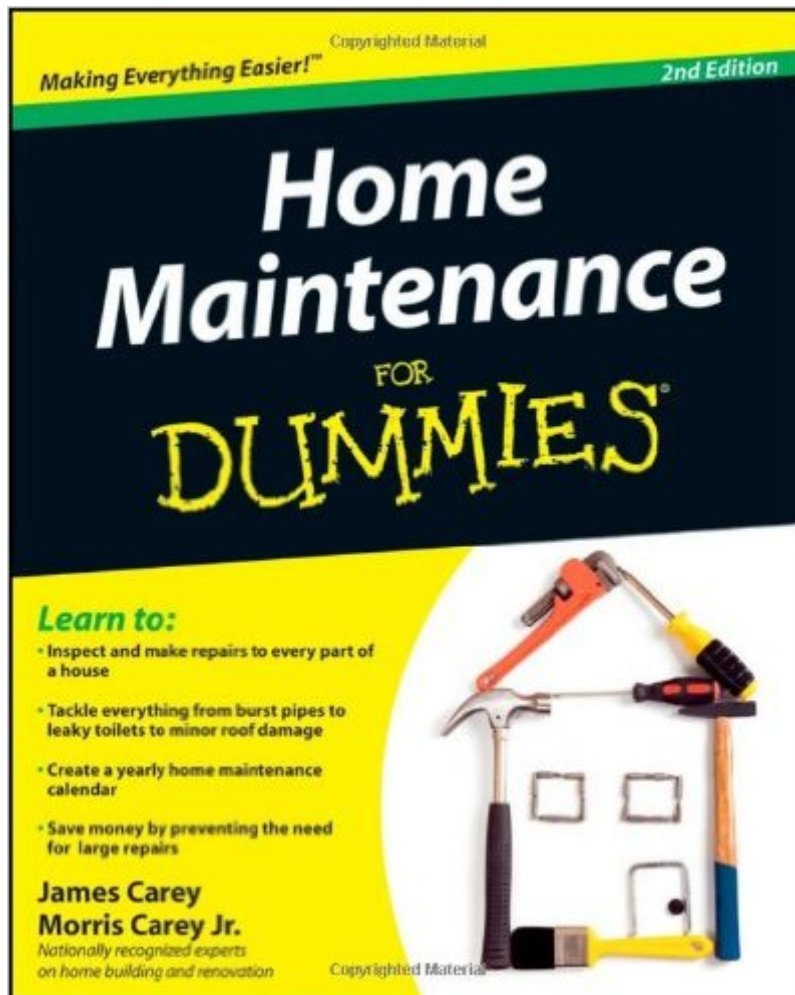

This book is a great overview to help the new homeowner be a little more savvy about maintaining

your house. It starts out explaining why home maintenance is important, getting to know the house, and putting together a plan. Sections include- The Energy Envelope (foundation, floors, roofing, siding, windows, doors, insulation)- Key Systems: Plumbing and HVAC- Inside Home Sweet Home (walls, ceilings, floors, cabinets, appliances, fireplaces, home-safety)- Out in the Great Wide Open (walkways, patios/decks, driveways, fences)- The Part of Tens (cleaning solutions, maintenance skills you need) There's even a handy to-do list that breaks down home maintenance into "musts," "shoulds," and "coulds." Plus a schedule of annual, seasonal, or monthly maintenance. The book helps me feel more comfortable knowing the basics of home maintenance. Cleaning, caulking, painting, leaks, cracks. It makes you feel more confident to take care of the little things around the house and avoid costly repairs later on.

We have been living in our current home for over 20 years but I purchased this book for my husband anyway as he is a big fan of the Carey Brothers. Scoring this at 2 because it is just too intense for most homeowners and DIY enthusiasts. A perfect example is a section on replacing a water valve. The reader, it is assumed, knows little to nothing about plumbing and what to do when a shut off valve leaks or no longer works properly. However, when it comes to installing the valve, the reader is told to "solder the valve in place". So, you don't know plumbing, but you do know how to solder properly? Great intentions from the authors, but the book gets far too deep for most, and those who understand the complications don't need the book.

It is useless if you want to take care of your home. In so many cases just say get a professional to do it...It does not explain how to do things. Just go over different types of heaters, ACs, etc but does not explain anything about maintenance.

Four-star book for the rookie maintenance job. Would be the kind of book that you'd have around the house for decades, and pull out once a year to get smart on one simple area of home maintenance. Easy to read, and even a 12-year old kid would be able to pour over the notes and do a job.
