

If you are collecting the quarters from the start (1999)this book is the same as the first book (1999-2003). It has both slots for the P and D. I ran into the problem of collecting the next years quarters (2004-now) and never got the book until just now. So happy they had them!

Does what it claims. Nothing exotic. Thought the paper would be a bit thicker, but my 9 year old daughter has done a good job of not jabbing her finger through any of the empty holes for coins, so that is promising. I have seen the "children's Washington quarters national parks" book and it is bigger and more interesting for children. I should have purchased that one instead, but chose these because I could create a coin collecting "set of books" pennies through quarters.

In one of these books I noticed that one of the coin slots had a rip through it...State Quarters 2004-2008Accidentally posted this review under Kennedy half dollar book as well. The 2004-2008

state quarter book is the one that is damaged (see photos).

I picked these up a few years ago and set them aside until now. Trying to get the quarters in is next to impossible - my thumbs are both extremely sore after just inserting 5 quarters and both the front cover was lifted off the binding and cover bent just trying to get the quarters to stay in. I've always used Whitman folders and will stick with those. I also noticed that the coating on the back cover which folds in and faces the coins on the front cover leaves some glazing of the coins. I ordered Book 3 just to complete the set, but will continue with the Whitman folders for my other collections.

It holds state quarters, what is there to not like about it. Honestly, I think it would be better if the slots were a little bit more sturdy. Once you put a quarter in there, if, for whatever reason, you take it back out, the hold widens.

Great way to store your quarters in a quick and easy way. Very convenient item, have to be careful not to rip it!

Good quality coin folder. I do prefer them to the Harris folders, but partially because I've been using Whitman folders for over 40 years. Great folders for beginners and casual collectors.

Is what it says. A great way to show off these cool quarters. By the way, to get them in the circular slots, simply roll the claw part of a hammer over the coin and it slides right in.
